Animal rights activists flood RWS Facebook page with messages

Animal rights activists have flooded Resorts World Sentosa's (RWS) Facebook page with hundreds of messages calling for it to release its captive dolphins.

The barrage of posts by supporters of a Singapore-based pressure group forced RWS to block some users and disable the page's comment function.

A spokesman on Monday called the activists' behaviour 'premeditated cyber harassment'

He said blocking users was 'never an ideal response', but added: 'We cannot and will not tolerate an misuse of our Facebook page with spam, repetitive or abusive messages.'
